

II CAMINO DE SANTIAGO: INTERNATIONAL OPEN FINAL STAGE

I. RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Final Stage will take place at the Real Aeroclub Santiago between 26th and 28th August. The 16 registered players will be divided into four groups (A, B, C and D) of four players each. If, after the publication of the definitive draws, there are any withdrawals, these can be covered directly by the next player on the replacement list without modifying the groups or the schedules already published. All the starting times of the matches are approximate, and each player must be available at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time. Finally, all players are allowed to practice for a maximum of 10 minutes before the start of each match.

FIRST ROUND (GROUP STAGE):

During the course of the group stage, all matches will be played as a single game of best of 19 hoops with no time limit and double banking. The player who wins a match will get 1 point, while the loser will get none. With this system, at the end of this group stage a classification will be obtained from the first to the fourth classified player in each group and only the first two players of each group will pass to the second round "KNOCK-OUT".

For the classification in this stage, the number of matches won will be taken into account firstly, secondly, the difference in hoops and, thirdly, the highest number of hoops in favour. In the case of tie, if it is between two players, the result of the particular confrontation between these two players will be taken into account, and in the case of a tie between three or all the players in the group, each player will take 5 shots to the peg and the two players who manage to hit it the most times will be the ones who will go on to the next round.

SECOND ROUND (KNOCK-OUT):

In this round the matches will be best of 3 games of 13 hoops each with no time limit and in double banking system. These playing conditions will be maintained until the end of the tournament.

When determining the crossings for this second round KNOCK OUT, the tournament director or, if applicable, the main referee will draw lots (after the group stage) on a "heads and tails" basis to determine which groups will be drawn against each other, as follows:

- HEADS = GROUP A will cross with GROUP C (and therefore GROUP B will cross with GROUP D).
- TAILS = GROUP A will cross with GROUP D (and therefore GROUP B will cross with GROUP C).

OBLIGATION AND COURTESY OF THE PLAYERS:

Players must wear white clothing and flat-soled shoes to play the matches. The winner of the toss shall wear clips when scoring a hoop (blue or red if the match is played with primary coloured balls and green or white if the match is played with the secondary game). The winner must communicate the result to the referees or starters so that they can record it on the boards provided for this purpose.



Players must be respectful to their opponents, referees / starters and spectators, and shouting and swearing is forbidden. For all matters not provided in this document the championship shall be governed by the WCF Golf Croquet Rules 2018 Edition.

During the celebration of the final stage, an audiovisual editor will be able to take and film individual or collective images of the participants and the attending public.
